
We are glad to share some information regarding the upcoming World Skate Games 2024 that will take place in Italy from 6th September to 10th September for the Inline Slalom discipline.

The event will take place at: Via Nicoletto Vernia, Chieti, Abruzzo.






The minimum width is 7m.

CATEGORIES AND COUNTRY QUOTAS

The categories allowed to compete are Junior: born in 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009 and Senior: born in 2005 and older.

Nation which representants reached the highest sum of World Cup points among the first 15 classified racers in overall standing of women and in overall standing of men during the previous year, has a quota of 35 women and 35 men of both senior and junior. Other nations have a quota of 15 racers per gender.

The last World Champions are pre-seeded into their relevant competition. Pre-seeded athletes do not count against the country quota.

The pre-seeded athletes will automatically be registered by World Skate and must NOT be registered by their National Federations. Please remember that the pre-seeded athletes will also have to pay the registration fee.

An updated version of the Downhill Inline Slalom's Rulebook will be published in the upcoming weeks.

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the WADA Code, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), incorporating the requirements of the Technical Document for Sport Specific Analysis (TDSSA), and following the instruction of the World Skate Anti-doping Manager/Delegate.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2022, 2023 and 2024 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the <u>WADA ADEL</u> <u>platform</u> and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the <u>WADA ADEL platform</u> is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.
